

**POSTER GUIDELINES**  
**SEVENTH EASTERN OLD-GROWTH CONFERENCE**  
March 24-25, 2006  
Little Rock, Arkansas

Posters will be displayed on 2-sided easels, with one author's poster on one side, and another author's poster on the other. The easels hold a square board that measures 48 inches on each side. This in turn makes vertically-oriented posters easier to display. Longer horizontal posters can be displayed if they are attached to some kind of stiff cardboard backing (this backing material **MUST** be provided by the author, as the meeting will provide only the easels). However, do not make posters any wider than 72 inches. We will provide thumbtacks to attach posters to the wooden easel boards, but other attachment materials (e.g., Velcro) can be used if they do not permanently fix or mar the surface of the easel.

Poster titles should be in large (1" tall or bigger) letters, and the poster content should be in a font large enough to read from 6 feet away. Pictures are strongly encouraged, and all text should be well-written and easy to follow.

The poster session will be held in the foyer just outside of the Conway Lecture Hall.

Posters should be set-up before the morning break (before 10 a.m.) so that presenters can stand by their poster for discussion during the morning break. Posters should be left until at least the afternoon break, and must be removed before the close of the meeting. Any posters left behind will be disposed of by the convention center staff, so if you want to keep your poster, make sure to take it with you!
