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MIDSOUTH PULPWOOD PRICES, 1983

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SUMMARY

The average price per cord for Midsouth roundwood pulpwood increased less than 1 percent to \$48.38 in 1983. The average price for a green ton of chipped mill residues fell 9.3 percent to \$23.34. Sawdust prices averaged \$13.04 per green ton, a 42.2 percent increase over 1982 prices. Prices for rail delivery of wood fiber continue to be slightly lower than truck delivery prices. The total expenditure for wood fiber in the Midsouth increased 6 percent to \$1,494.7 million in 1983.

Midsouth pulpwood prices for 1983 are based on information supplied by 45 mills that collectively account for more than 70 percent of the wood fiber receipts in Alabama, Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, Tennessee, and Texas. The prices reported are for pulpwood deliveries to the pulpmill, mechanized yard, or rail car and do not include freight, woodyard, overhead, or similar expenses. All prices are based on standard units - cords for roundwood and green tons for byproducts. When necessary, reported units were converted to standard units by the U.S. Forest Service.

Average prices per cord for roundwood, softwood roundwood, and hardwood roundwood increased less than 1 percent

in 1983 (Table 1). The average price for chipped mill residues fell 9.3 percent to \$23.34 per green ton. Softwood and hardwood chip prices fell to \$24.47 and \$18.73 per green ton, a drop from 1982 prices of 12.5 percent and 9.9 percent respectively (Table 2). The average price for a green ton of sawdust increased to \$13.04, a 42.2 percent increase over 1982 prices. Softwood sawdust prices also increased, up 48.6 percent to \$14.80 per green ton, while hardwood sawdust prices fell 7.6 percent to \$7.78 per green ton (Table 3).

The price breakdown by truck and rail deliveries (Tables 4 and 5) shows that roundwood prices for either delivery method have remained at 1982 levels (+ 2 percent). In contrast, chipped residue prices for either delivery method have fallen below 1982 levels, except for rail deliveries of hardwood chips which increased by 1.1 percent. As in previous years, average roundwood and chip rail prices, \$46.72 per cord and \$22.99 per green ton, have been lower than average truck prices for roundwood and chips, \$49.32 per cord and \$23.66 per green ton. The price difference reflects the transportation costs from rail siding to millyard. Truck delivery accounts for two-thirds of the total roundwood receipts, while chipped residue deliveries are equally split between truck and rail.

By applying the average 1983 prices to 1983 pulpwood production figures, the total expenditure in the Midsouth region

for wood fiber in 1983 was calculated to be \$1,494.7 million, an increase of 6 percent over 1982's \$1,407.7 million. Of the total 1983 expenditure, 63.5 percent went towards roundwood purchases, 35.5 percent went towards chipped residue purchases, and the remaining 1.0 percent went towards sawdust purchases. Because

roundwood prices have remained relatively constant and chipped residue prices have fallen below 1982 levels, most of the increase in the total expenditure between 1982 and 1983 can be attributed to the 7 percent increase in Midsouth pulpwood production in 1983.
