While out yesterday on the snow day I read the Summary Report of the Southern Forest Resource Assessment...

I have a few editorial comments-

On page 15 under Figure 2.5 there's a missing number in the caption it should read "1995" and not "199."

On page 74, Figure 3.3.6 the figure illustrates "public" land in the South, unless I'm mistaken the figure maps federal ownership and not all public. Unless you've defined "public" somewhere in the report as referencing federal land, I'd suggest replacing "public" with "federal" in the caption.

On page 79, there is a spelling in the last paragraph. ".0of" should be simply "of."

On page 84, first paragraph under Conservation issues, last sentence of the paragraph, unless changes have been made recently to the Wetlands Reserve Program, conservation easements therein could be both thirty year and perpetual.

And nitpicking on page 86, near the bottom of the page there is an extra blank row that should be deleted.

As far as content, looks alright to me. I try to tear into the big document next week.
